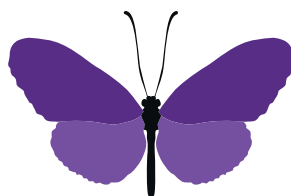

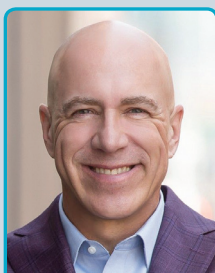

## KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

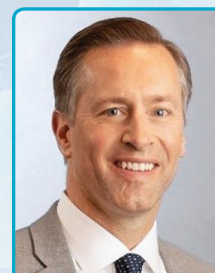
